

HOUGHTON & WYTON PARISH COUNCIL

This notice is to inform anyone with an interest that the Parish Council of Houghton & Wyton is considering making a Dogs on Lead Control Order making it an offence for a person in charge of a dog to fail to keep the dog on a lead of maximum length one metre at any time when entering and using the land known as Houghton & Wyton Village Playing Field.

The Order, if made, will apply to all land bounded by St Ives Road, Victoria Crescent, Laughtons Lane and the A1123.

A map of the area to be covered by the proposed order can be viewed at the Parish Clerk's office by arrangement.

Already in place in this area is a Fouling of Land by Dogs Order making it an offence for anyone to fail to remove dog faeces deposited by a dog for which he or she is responsible. This Control Order will remain in force.

Houghton & Wyton Parish Council, after many complaints, have been forced to take this action as numerous notices and articles published over a long period of time have not prevented the regular fouling of this area by dogs.

Houghton & Wyton Parish Council invites any representation on the proposal.
